

## DESIGN FOR AN ALTO-RELIEVO.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8.212, dated March 23, 1875; application filed February 13, 1875.

[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Josef Christe, of Newark, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented a new and original Design for Alto-Relievo, of which the following is a specification:
