DESIGN FOR A CAST.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Joseph W. Fiske, of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented certain Improvements in a Design for a Lion, of which

the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is hereby made.

It represents a lion sitting on its haunches, on a suitable base or slab, the whole being

made of a single piece, either of cast metal or other suitable material, as represented in the illustration.

What I claim as my invention is—
