DESIGN FOR A CAST.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,214**, dated March 23, 1875; application filed March 6, 1875.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOSEPH W. FISKE, of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented certain Improvements in Design for a Dog, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is hereby made. It consists of the figure of a New Foundland dog, represented standing, as shown in the illus-

tration, and may be made with or without the slab or base on which it is shown as standing, the whole being made of cast metal or other material.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design for a cast representing the figure of a dog, as herein shown and described.
