## DESIGN FOR DISHES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,221**, dated March 23, 1875; application filed January 16, 1875.  
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, STEWART B. CLOSE, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for Sandwich Holders and vessels for similar purposes, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

*a* represents the glass body of the holder. *b* is the bottom, also of glass. *c* is a metallic ring around the top. *d* is the metallic cover. *e* is an ornamental molding which surrounds the bottom of the holder, to which is attached

the ornamental open-work base-ring *f*, which forms the base of the holder.

The body *a* is made of transparent glass, but may be ornamented in any desired manner.

I claim as my invention—

A design for a sandwich-holder composed of the cylindrical body *a*, beaded top ring *c*, molding *e*, and ornamental open-work base-ring *f*, as shown and described.
