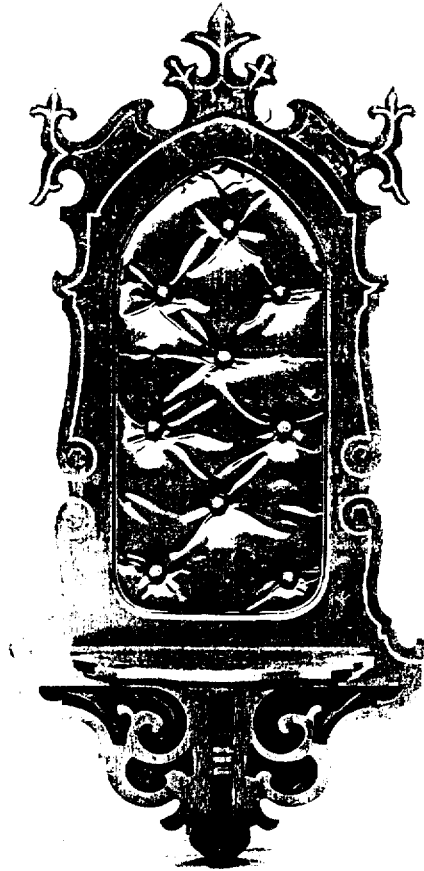

DESIGN FOR WALL-BRACKET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,223**, dated March 23, 1875; application filed March 13, 1875.
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HYLA H. PEACOCK, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a Design for Wall-Bracket, of which the following is a specification:

My design for a bracket is fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration; and consists of a vertical ornamented frame, A, to bear against the wall, and a shelf, B, for supporting any ornamental object. In this frame A is a panel fitted with a padded fabric, D, of a color which may best serve to display the statuary or other ornament intended to be placed on the shelf B.

I claim as my invention—

The design for a bracket having a panel of padded fabric within an ornamented frame, substantially as described, and as illustrated in and by the accompanying drawing.
