

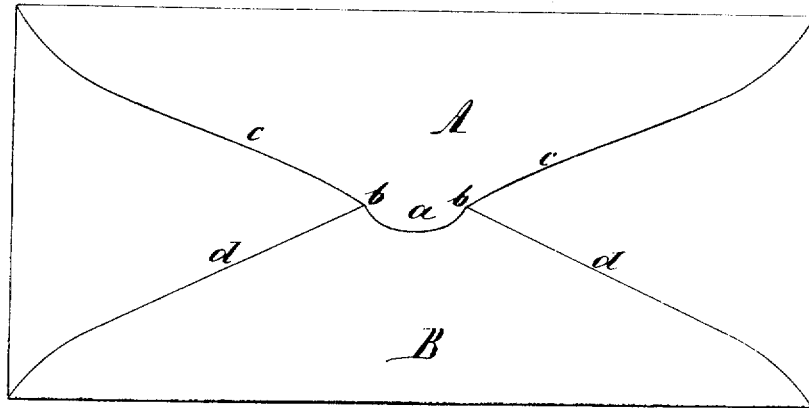

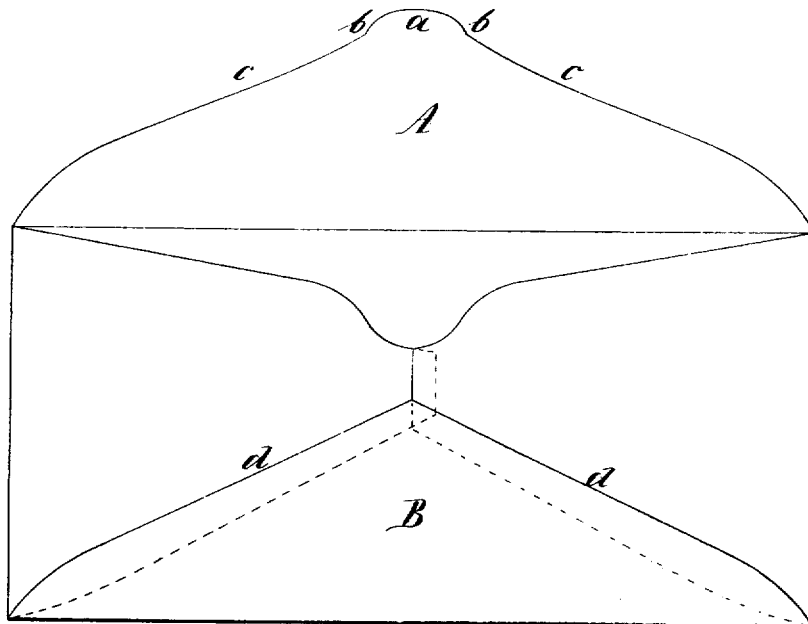

## DESIGN FOR ENVELOPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,225**, dated March 23, 1875; application filed March 13, 1875.  
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

### CASE A.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ROBERT SNEIDER, of Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a certain new Design for Envelope, of which the following is a specification:

This invention is illustrated in the accompanying drawing, in which—

Figure 1 represents an elevation of my envelope when the same is closed. Fig. 2 is a similar view of the same when it is open.

Similar letters indicate corresponding parts.

My design consists in a semi-oval lip on the closing-flap, said lip forming sharp corners with the sides of the flap, whereby a novel and distinguished appearance is imparted to my envelope. When the envelope is closed, the corners of the projecting lip of the closing-flap meet the sides of the bottom flap.

In the drawing, the letter A designates the closing-flap, and the letter B the bottom flap, of my envelope. On the tip of the closing-

flap is formed a semi-oval lip, *a*, which is cut out in such a manner that sharp corners *b b* are produced between it and the sides *c c* of said flap. The sides *d d* of the bottom flap are rectilinear almost throughout their entire length, and when the envelope is closed the corners *b b* of the lip *a* meet the sides *d d* of the bottom flap, as shown in Fig. 1. By these means an envelope is obtained which has a novel and distinguished appearance.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for an envelope, consisting of a semi-oval lip, *a*, on the closing-flap A, said lip forming sharp corners *b b* with the sides of the flap, as shown and described.
