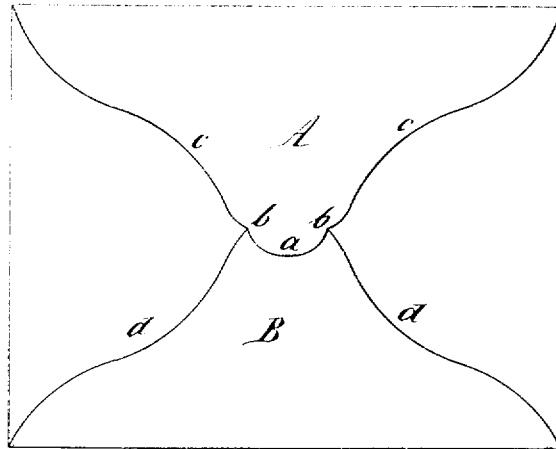
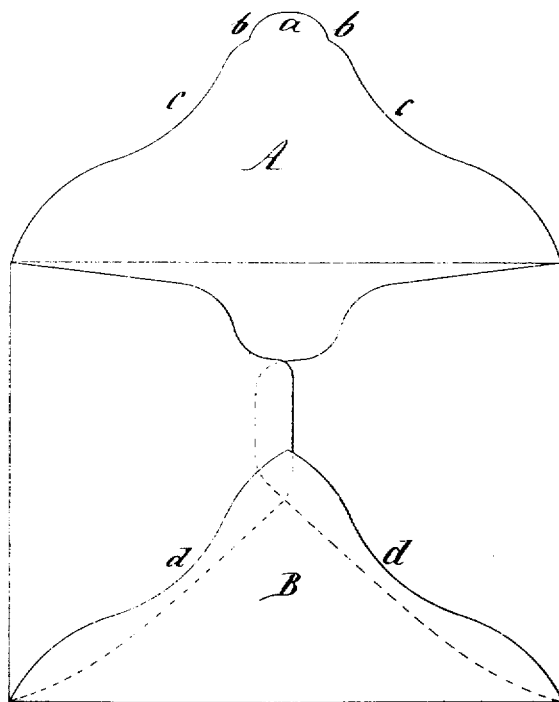

DESIGN FOR ENVELOPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,226**, dated March 23, 1875; application filed March 13, 1875.
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

CASE B.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ROBERT SNEIDER, of Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a certain new Design for Envelope, of which the following is a specification:

This invention is illustrated in the accompanying drawing, in which Figure 1 represents an elevation of my envelope when the same is closed. Fig. 2 is a similar view of the same when open.

Similar letters indicate corresponding parts.

My design consists in a semi-oval lip formed at the tip of the closing-flap, the sides of which are ogee-shaped, and form sharp corners with said lip. The sides of the bottom flap are also ogee-shaped, and when the envelope is closed, the corners of the projecting lip meet these ogee-shaped edges.

In the drawing, the letter A designates the closing-flap, and the letter B the bottom flap, of my envelope. On the tip of the closing-flap is formed a semi-oval lip, *a*, which forms sharp corners *b b* with the ogee-shaped side edges *c c* of said closing-flap. The side edges

d d of the bottom flap B are also ogee-shaped, as shown. When the envelope is closed, the corners *b b* of the lip *a* on the closing-flap meet the ogee-shaped edges *d d* of the bottom flap.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

1. The design for an envelope, consisting of a semi-oval lip, *a*, on the closing-flap A, the ogee-shaped side edges *c c* of said closing-flap, and the corners *b b* between the side edges *c c* and the lip *a*, as shown and described.

2. The design for an envelope, consisting of a semi-oval lip, *a*, on the closing-flap A, the ogee-shaped side edges *c c* of said closing-flap, the corners *b b* between the side edges *c c* and the lip *a*, and ogee-shaped side edges *d d* of the bottom flap B, as shown and described.
