## DESIGN FOR A BORDER FOR SHIRT-FRONTS, &c.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,228**, dated March 23, 1875; application filed January 29, 1875.  
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, CHARLES FREDERIC VETTER, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have produced or invented a Design for a Stripe or Border, of which the following is a specification:

My design for a stripe or border for shirt-fronts and other articles of wearing apparel is fully shown in the accompanying drawing, and consists of two stripes, *A*, and an intervening space, *d*, which has a central row of stars, *e*, and is provided at intervals with a portrait, *f*. The stripes *A* are composed of two parallel ribs, *a* and *b*, inclosing a space, *c*, the ribs being colored.

I claim—

1. The design for a border or stripe for shirts

and other articles of wearing apparel, composed of the ribs *a b*, the stars *e*, and portrait *f*, as described, and as illustrated in the accompanying drawing.

2. The design for a stripe for shirts and other articles of wearing apparel, having the ornamented space *d*, with its central row of stars *e* and portrait *f*, substantially as described, and as illustrated in the accompanying drawing.
