## DESIGN FOR FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,240, dated March 30, 1875; application filed February 18, 1874.

[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CARL EMIL HEYER, of Boston, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a Design for a Font of Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying impression from the types, to which reference is made. The face (consisting of lower-case letters only) is of an unusually condensed character; and What I claim is—

The design for a font of printing-types, as herein shown and described.
