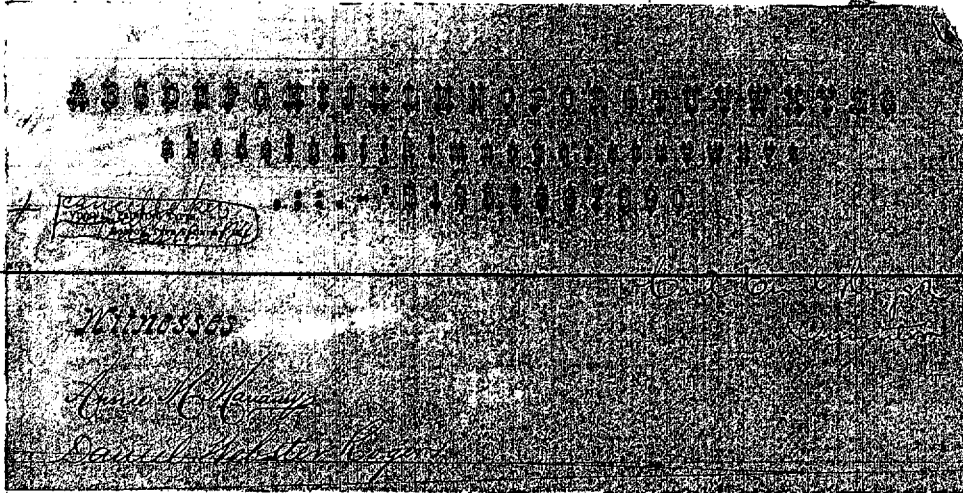

DESIGN FOR FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **S,241**, dated March 30, 1875; application filed February 18, 1874.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CARL EMIL HEYER, of Boston, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a Design for a Font of Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:
