## DESIGN FOR FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,244, dated March 30, 1875; application filed March 22, 1875. [Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CARL EMIL HEYER, of
Boston, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a Design for a Font of Printing-Types, of which the follow-

ing is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying impression from the types, to which reference is made.

The face is very wide and heavy in its char-

acter, generally resembling the style known as "Black," but combining to some extent the "Roman" style in the capitals; and What I claim is—

The design for a font of printing types, as herein shown and described.
