DESIGN FOR FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,245**, dated March 30, 1875; application filed March 10, 1875. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, PETER A. JORDAN, (assignor to MACKELLAR, SMITHS & JORDAN,) of the city and county of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Font of Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:
