

DESIGN FOR BACKS OF LEATHER BRUSHES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,260, dated April 13, 1875; application filed March 30, 1875.

[Term of Patent 3; years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Wm. H. Humphrey, of Lansingburg, in the county of Rensselaer and State of New York, have invented a certain new Design for the Back of Leather Brushes; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawings and to the letters of reference marked thereon, which form part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

A represents a piece of leather, of which the backs of leather brushes are to be made. In the leather A is stamped or pressed the representation of a running deer attacked by two

dogs, and this is surrounded by a circular border, in which is a wreath of leaves.

The back of each brush may have one of these designs stamped or pressed upon it; but I prefer to have two of them, exactly alike, and placed in opposite directions, as shown in the drawing.

What I claim as my invention is-

A design for the back of a leather brush, consisting of a deer attacked by two dogs, and surrounded by a circular wreath of leaves, substantially as shown and described.
