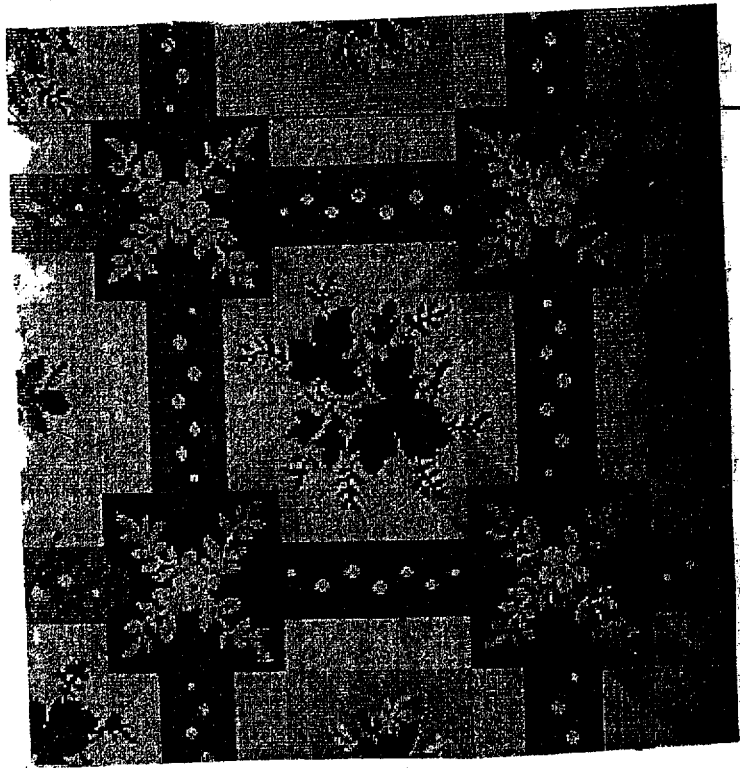

DESIGN FOR OIL-CLOTHS.
