## DESIGN FOR BREASTPIN.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,275**, dated April 20, 1875; application filed April 9, 1875.  
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

### CASE B.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, LEONARD S. BEALS, of Astoria, in the county of Queens and State of New York, have invented a Design for Breastpin, of which the following is a specification:

This invention is illustrated in the accompanying drawing, in which Figure 1 represents a face view. Fig. 2 is a sectional view.

Similar letters indicate corresponding parts.

This design consists of an oblong escutcheon bearing an angular button and heart-shaped shells, the button being ornamented with a central head and with a circle of pearls.

In the drawing, the letter A designates my breastpin. *a* is its escutcheon, which is of oblong form, having straight sides and curved ends. The face of the escutcheon contains a button, *b*, of angular outline, and on either side of the button are shells *c*, which are heart-shaped. The button *b* is ornamented with a central circular head, *d*, surrounded by a circle of pearls, *e*. The head *d* and circle *e* are

contained in a recess, *f*, of the button. The shells *c* are ornamented with interior radiations *g*, as shown.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

1. The design for a breastpin composed of the oblong escutcheon *a*, angular button *b*, and heart-shaped shells *c*, substantially as shown and described.

2. The design for a breastpin composed of the escutcheon *a*, angular button *b*, with its central head *d* and circle *e*, and of the heart-shaped shells *c*, substantially as shown and described.
