

DESIGN FOR STREET-LAMP POSTS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,293, dated April 27, 1875; application filed April 10, 1875.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

CASE B.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM TWEEDDALE, of Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for a Street-Lamp Post, of which the following is a specification:

My design for a street-lamp is fully represented in the accompanying print, to which

reference is made.

It consists of the concave band g, convex band h, plain bands i, raised ribs j, with coiled upper and lower terminations k l, branching spires m, and the beads n for the upper portion of the lamp-post; also the flat and oval ribbed or fluted strips o and p, with the scroll figures q for the middle portion of the post; also the circular figures r, with the center boss s, and scalloped projecting figures t for the upper portion of the base; and also the oval figures u, leaf-shaped figures v, and fruit-pieces v for the lower portion of the base.

I claim as my invention-

- 1. The concave band g, convex band h, plain bands i, raised ribs j, with coiled upper and lower terminations k l, branching spires m, and beads n, as a design for lamp-posts, as set forth.
- 2. The flat and oval ribbed or fluted strips op, and scroll figures q as a design for lampposts, as set forth.
- 3. The circular figures r, with center boss s, and scalloped projections t as a design for lamp-posts, as set forth.
- 4. The oval figures u, leaf-shaped figures v, and the fruit-pieces w, as a design for a lamppost, as set forth.
