## DESIGN FOR CUFF-BUTTONS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,312, dated May 4, 1875; application filed April 9, 1875. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LEONARD S. BEALS, of Astoria, in the county of Queens and State of New York, have invented a certain new Design for Cuff-Buttons, of which the following is a specification:

This invention is illustrated in the accom-

panying drawing, in which-

Figure 1 represents a face view. Fig. 2 is a sectional view.

Similar letters indicate corresponding parts. This design consists of an angular button bearing a central head and a circle of pearls, the two latter being contained within a circular recess.

In the drawing, the letter A designates my button, which has a square outline, and is formed with a circular recess, a. Within the recess a, and in the center of the button, is a head, b, which is surrounded by a circle, e, of

pearls. The head b has a circular outline. The face of the button A is ornamented with triangular indentations so disposed as to form a zigzag line, d, near its edge.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure

by Letters Patent, is—'
1. The design of the angular button A, central head b, and the circle c, substantially as shown and described.

2. The design of the angular button A, central head b, circle c, and recess a, substantially as shown and described.
