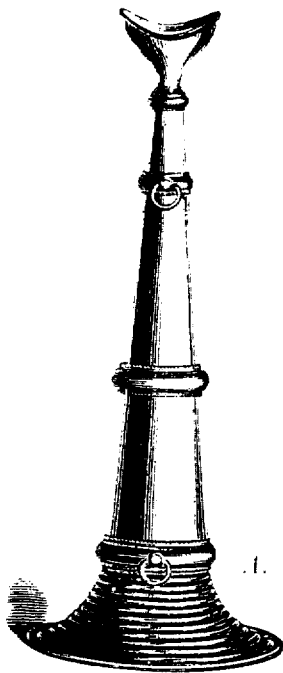

DESIGN FOR FIREMAN'S TRUMPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,334**, dated May 18, 1875; application filed March 29, 1875.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FRED. J. MILLER, of Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a Design for Firemen's Trumpets, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying engraving, to which reference is made.

My invention consists of a design for a fireman's trumpet, the bell or bowl A of which is

corrugated, the corrugations running around the bell or bowl A, substantially in the manner shown.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design for a fireman's trumpet, substantially as herein described and shown.
