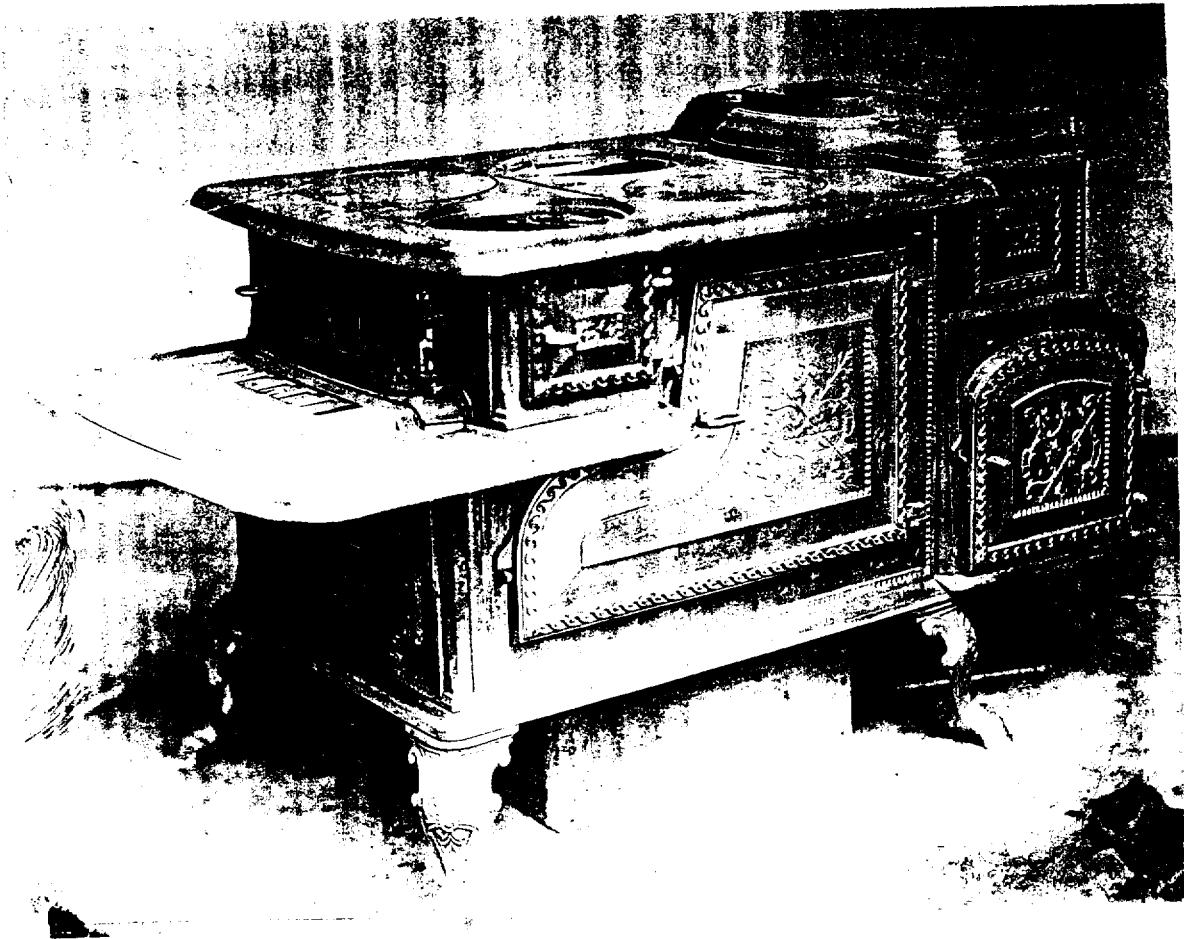

DESIGN FOR STOVE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,337**, dated May 18, 1875; application filed May 8, 1875.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, NICHOLAS S. VEDDER, of Troy, New York, have invented a Design for Stoves, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

A represents one portion of the design, such as is intended to be used upon the principal oven-door, while B represents another part of the design, intended for use upon the lesser oven-door—C representing that part of the de-

sign to be used upon the fire and smaller doors, the whole design being as represented in the photographic drawing; A, B, and C being intended for conjunctive use, and as portions of one design.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a stove, consisting of the parts A, B, and C, as shown.
