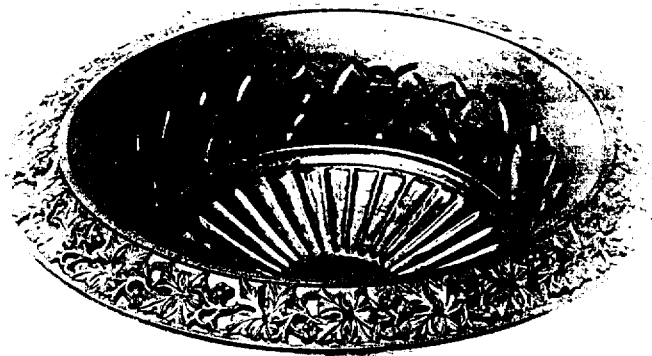

DESIGN FOR A BORDER FOR VASES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,310**, dated May 25, 1875; application filed April 19, 1875
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MELVILLE D. JONES, of Boston, Suffolk county, Massachusetts, have invented an Ornamental Design for Lip or Border of Vase-Bowl, of which the following is a specification:

The design is upon the overhanging lip or border *A*, which constitutes the extreme circumference of the bowl of a vase, and consists in creating or affixing upon such border a continuous vine, composed of leaves known as Gothic oak.

The vine is made up of a series of leaves, *a*, &c., alternating with twigs *b b*, &c., of a corresponding character, bearing clusters *c c*,

&c., of berries, the whole being in basso-relievo upon a ground inclosed between raised edges *e e*, which constitute the limits or boundary of the lip *A*.

I claim—

The ornamental design for the top border of a vase, consisting of the vine composed of the Gothic-oak leaves *aa*, &c., twigs *bb*, &c., to correspond therewith, and clusters *cc*, &c., of berries, substantially as described, and shown in the accompanying illustration.
