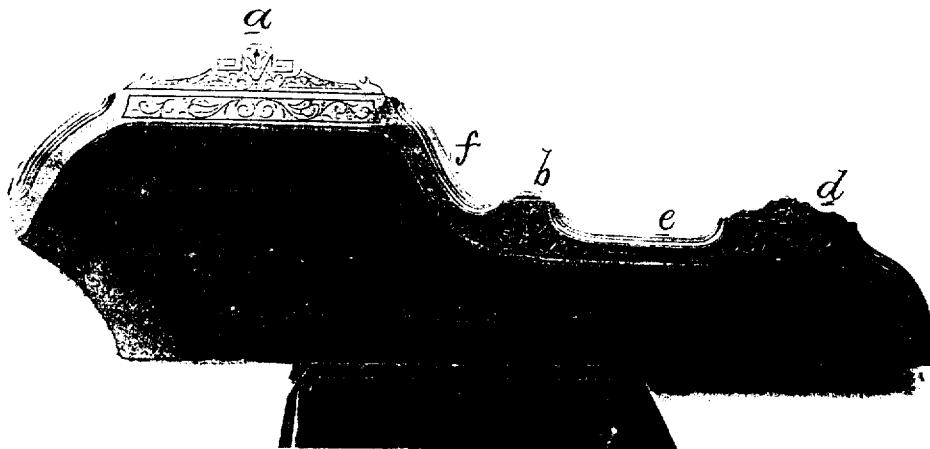

## DESIGN FOR BACKS OF LOUNGES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,354**, dated May 25, 1875; application filed April 2, 1875.  
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

### CASE C.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, GEORGE HARTZELL, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a Design for the Back of a Lounge, of which the following is a specification:

My design for the back of a lounge is fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration, and comprises the ornamented portions *a*, *b*, and *d*, the straight edging *e*, and curved edging *f*. The said straight edging *e* and curved edging *f* terminate at the ornamented portions *a*, *b*, and *d* in short curves, and the said ornamented portions are embellished with scroll-work of a character too clearly represented in the drawing to need detailed description.

I claim—

The design for the back of a lounge, comprising the ornamented portions *a*, *b*, and *d*, straight edging *e*, and curved edging *f*, all substantially as described, and as illustrated in and by the accompanying drawing.
