## DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **S,376**, dated June 8, 1875; application filed February 18, 1874.

[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, CARL EMIL HEYER, of Boston, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a Design for a Font of Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying impression from the types, to which reference is made.

This face consists of capitals, small caps,

figures and points, and is, in outline, similar to a face heretofore patented, but opened and ornamented.

What I claim is—

The design for a font of printing-types, as herein shown and described.
