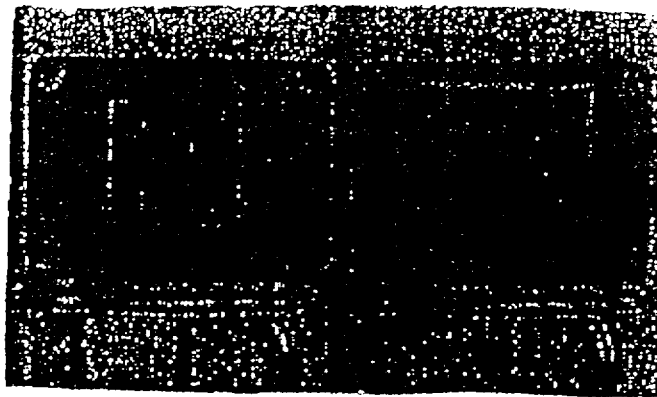

DESIGN FOR A GAME-BOARD.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,398**, dated June 15, 1875; application filed May 28, 1875.

[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES G. HARGER, Jr., of Watertown, Jefferson county, New York, have invented a Design for a Game-board, of which the following is a specification:

My design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic representation of the sides of the board, to which reference is made.

The board A is in the form of an oblong parallelogram, with rounded corners B, and the decalcomanic or other decorations C in the corners, and on one side figured for chess or checkers E, also having counters F for casino, and also counters G for cribbage, and the other

side is figured for backgammon H, and decorated with decalcomanic or other ornaments I.

I claim as my invention—

As a design for a game-board, the round-cornered parallel-sided board A, with ornamentations C, chess-board E, and counters F G on one side, and backgammon-board H on the other side, as shown in the accompanying photographic illustration.
