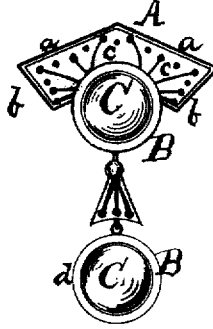
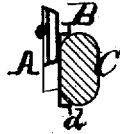

DESIGN FOR BREASTPIN.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,407**, dated June 22, 1875; application filed June 2, 1875.
[Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.]

CASE B'.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LEONARD S. BEALS, of Astoria, in the county of Queens and State of New York, have originated and designed a Pattern for Breastpin and Pendant, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, in which—

Figure 1 represents a face view. Fig. 2 is a transverse section.

Similar letters indicate corresponding parts.

The body A of my breastpin is formed with a roof-shaped top edge, *a*, and inclined sides *b b*, and its face is ornamented by cords *c*. From said body rises a cup, B, provided with

a flat, polished rim, *d*. Said cup contains a coral, C. The pendant is composed of a similar cup and coral.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

1. The design for a breastpin, the body A of which has a roof-shaped top edge, *a*, and inclined sides *b b*, as shown and described.

2. The design for a breastpin, composed of a body, A, and cup B, containing a coral, C, all as shown and described.
