DESIGN FOR SCARF-RING.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,409, dated June 22, 1875; application filed June 2, 1875. [Term of Patent 31 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LEONARD S. BEALS, of Astoria, in the county of Queens and State of New York, have originated and designed a Pattern for Scarf-Rings, of which the follow-ing is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing making part of this specification:

The nature of my design is fully represent-

ed in the accompanying drawing, in which Figure 1 represents a face view. Fig. 2 is a

longitudinal section.

Similar letters indicate corresponding parts. The body A of my scarf-ring is ornamented by strings of beads a a and by a series of raised projections, b. From the center of the body A rises a cup, B, with a flat polished rim, and in this cup is contained a coral, C.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure

by Letters Patent, is—
The design for a scarf-ring, composed of a body, A, and cup B, the body A being ornamented by beads a a and projections b and the cup being provided with a flat polished rim and carrying a coral or other bead, all as shown and described.
