## DESIGN FOR BOTTLES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,417, dated June 22, 1875; application filed June 9, 1875.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Job Truax, of Mt. Union, in the county of Hunt and State of Pennsylvania, have invented certain new and useful Improvements in Designs for Bottles; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the invention, such as will enable others skilled in the art to which it pertains to make and use it, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, which form part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustra-

tion, to which reference is made.

A represents a bottle, the body of which is of a short cylindrical form, of which the rounded edges B are projecting beyond the flat sides, and also beyond the circumference, of the bottle. A rectangular foot, C, is formed upon the

circumference of the cylinder, extending across from one edge to the other, and joined to both. Opposite to the foot, on the upper side of the bottle, is placed the neck D, upon an enlargement of the circumference of the cylinder, which enlargement is joined to and level with the rounded edges. The neck is cylindrical, with an enlarged ring around its upper edge.

What I claim as my invention is—

A design for a bottle, having the flat circular body A, bottom C, rib B, and neck D, substantially as herein shown and described.
