

DESIGN FOR STOVES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,441, dated June 29, 1875; application filed June 5, 1875. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM BURROWS, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a Design for a Stove, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which refer-

ence is made.

The urn A, also the upper section C, also upper mica section D, also the lower mica section J, also the base section E, and also the base F, are ornamented with pieces of encaustic tile inserted in openings in the plates, or secured behind the openings in any approved way, so as to show in the front view.

I claim as my design for the ornamentation of stoves—

1. The design of an urn, A, ornamented with tiles B, as shown and described.

2. The design of an upper-stove section, C, ornamented with tiles G, as shown and described.

3. The design of median stove section, ornamented with tiles H, as shown and described.
