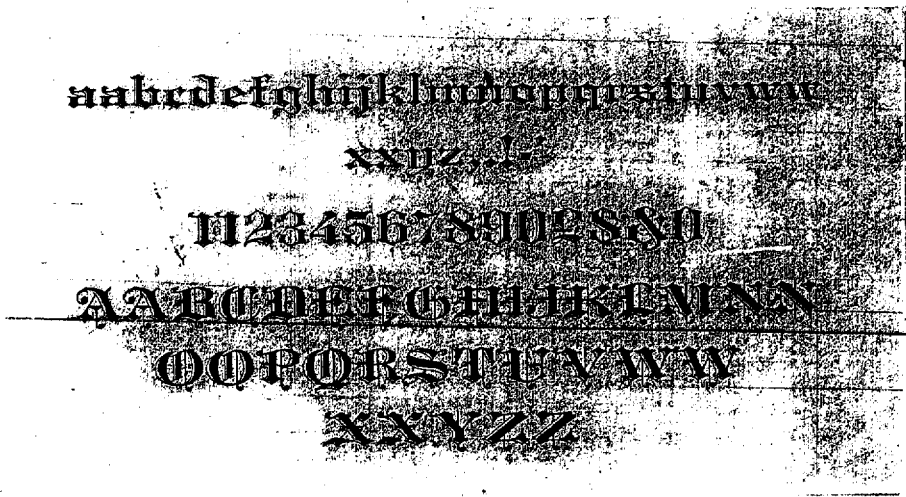

DESIGN FOR PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **S,416**, dated June 29, 1875; application filed June 5, 1875.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

CASE A.

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, CARL EMIL HEYER, of Boston, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a Design for Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification :

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying impression from the types, to which reference is made.

The face is very wide, with a shade-line on the left and down sides, and generally resem-

bles the style known as "black," but combines to some extent the Roman style in the capitals; and

What I claim is—

The design for a font of printing-types, as shown and described.
