## DESIGN FOR PRINTING-TYPE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,454**, dated July 6, 1875; application filed June 23, 1875.  
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JULIUS HERRIET, of the city, county, and State of New York, have originated and designed a new and original Pattern or Design for a Font of Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully illustrated in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and consists of an ornamented capital letter with top and bottom of increased weight, and having a white pearl or depression therein. The letter is

surrounded by a continuous outline slightly shaded at the right side and bottom, and having depressions or marks corresponding with those on the inner body of the letter.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design or pattern for a font of printing-types, herein shown and described.
