

DESIGN FOR A NUBIA.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,456, dated July 6, 1875; application filed June 7, 1875. [Term of Patent 3½ years.]

CASE B.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, James Phipps, of the city and county of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, have originated and designed a Pattern for a Nubia, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, making part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustrations, to which reference is made.

A represents a portion of the body of the nubia, and B B figures formed by inserting serpentine and zigzag threads, which run lengthwise with the nubia. The body may be ornamented with any figures that may be se-

lected; but each figure B consists of two serpentine threads, \vec{b} b, wove a certain distance apart, and forming the edging of the figure, between which are two threads, ec, grouped together and run in zigzag lines.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design for a nubia, consisting of the figures B B, each of which is composed of the threads bb, wove in a serpentine direction, and threads cc, wove in a zigzag form, substantially in the manner shown and described. JAMES PHIPPS.
