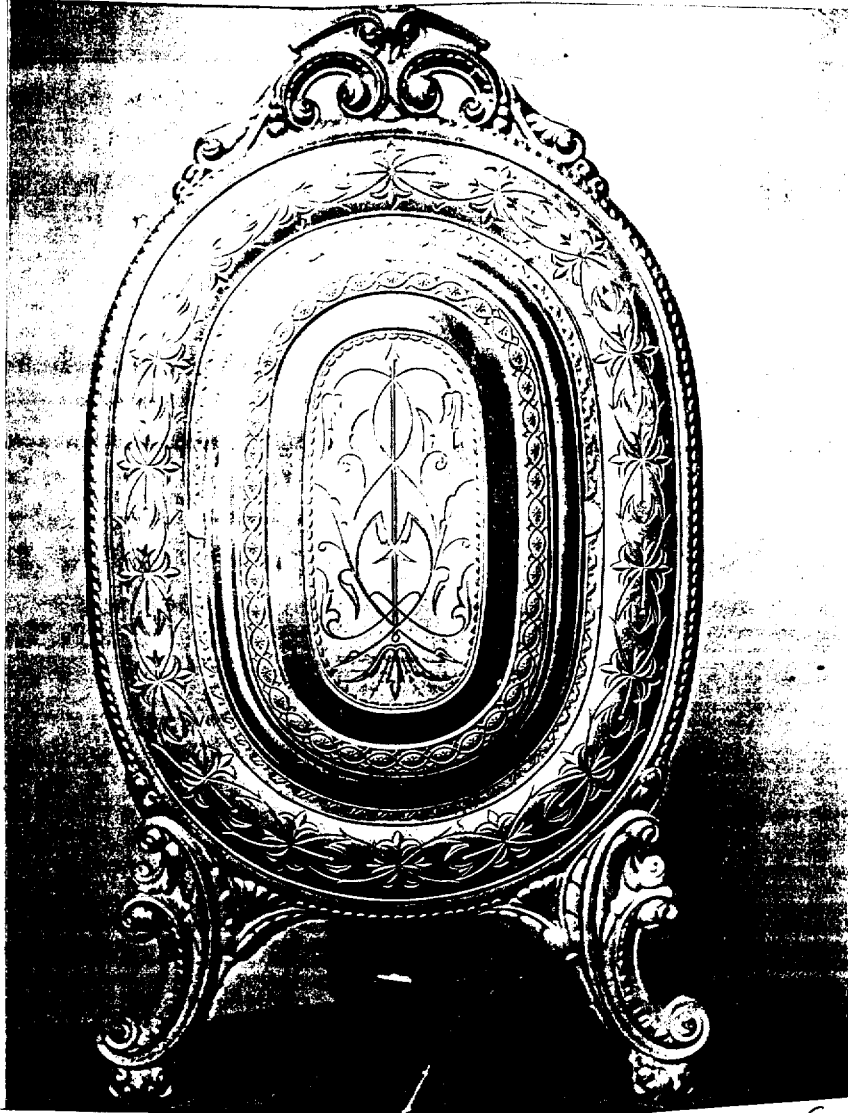

DESIGN FOR STOVES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,459**, dated July 6, 1875; application filed June 26, 1875.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, NICHOLAS S. VEDDER, of the city of Troy, in the State of New York, have originated and designed a Pattern for Stoves, of which the following is a description, reference being had to the photographic illustration accompanying and being part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

A represents the central figure, which is ornamented, as shown, and surrounded by a plain surface, beyond which is an ornamental border, B, composed of oval figures touching at their apexes, and connected as shown. A second plain border encompasses the border B, and is surrounded by a third fancy border, C, ornamented with truncated pyramidal fig-

ures having studs at their bases, which impinge. The border C is surrounded by a border, D, composed of a vine running in oval figures, and ornamented by leaves crossing at the points where the ovals connect. The border D is framed by a plain bead.

The design is oval in general formation, and is intended to be cast in and upon the end of a "Todd" stove.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

A design for a stove, composed of the ornamental figures or formations A, B, C, and D, arranged substantially as shown and described.
