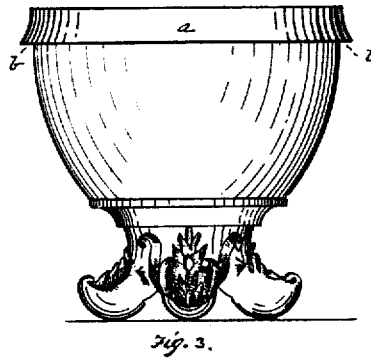
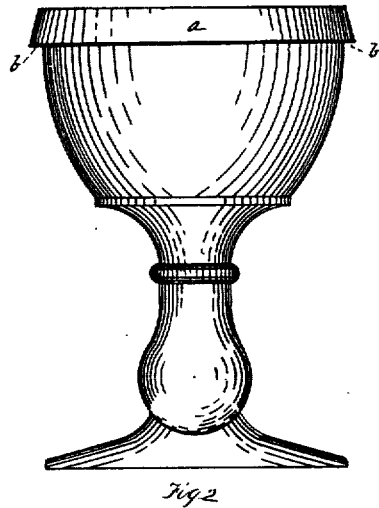
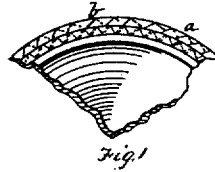

## DESIGN FOR GLASSWARE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,464**, dated July 6, 1875; application filed June 17, 1875.  
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JAMES B. LYON, of Pittsburg, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new and useful Improvement in Design for Glassware; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part of this specification, in which—

Figure 1 is a view of a stemmed glass bowl, showing my improved design; and Fig. 2 is a sugar-bowl, also showing the same design.

My new and useful design consists of a glass article—such as a bowl, goblet, cream-pitcher, dish, &c.—having a bead, projection, or rib on the outer surface, near the mouth or edge, such bead, projection, or rib flaring outward and downward either on a straight line or a curve, as shown, forming an inclined surface. This rib is shown at *a*. It is designed to be

applied to a full set of table glassware. When desired, the under surface of the projection *a* is ornamented, as at *b*, for the purpose of refracting the light through it, and thereby increasing its beauty.

I claim—

1. The design for glassware shown and described, consisting of an article having a flaring projection formed on and around the outer surface, near the edge.

2. The design for glassware shown and described, consisting of an article of glassware, having a flaring projection ornamented on its under surface, formed on and around the outer surface, near the edge.
