

DESIGN FOR A HEATING-STOVE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,483, dated July 13, 1875; application filed June 4, 1875. [Term of Patent 31 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, ROBERT SCORER and ROBERT HAM, of Troy, New York, have invented a Design for Heating-Stove, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of our design is fully represented in the accompanying engraving, to which reference is made.

A represents the base of the heating-stove. B and C are two moldings upon the base, the former being vertical, and the latter a horizontal one. These moldings B and C have in bas-relief and against a plain ground a chain of diamonds which girdle the stove. In the center of the diamonds is a Gothic figure, the shape of which is immaterial.

This Gothic center is shown depressed, but

it may be in alto-relievo.

Diverging lines from D point to two borders around the base of the stove, consisting of serrated or saw-tooth edges. E represents a border surrounding the vertical and convex portion of the base, consisting of a series of cross lines and links, intertwining and crossing each other, as shown.

We prefer to make the pattern as shown:

but it will be seen that the figures may be in bas-relief or alto-relievo, or may be changed in some other immaterial respect, without impairing the general design.

We are aware that diamonds, Gothic figures, and bars have been used in the ornamentation of stoves, and we do not claim them broadly in that connection. We do believe, however, that the peculiar arrangements and combinations of the diamonds, Gothic figures, and links and bars, in the engraving shown and in this specification explained, are new and original.

We do not claim the design shown for the base fire-pot and illuminating sections and their rearward extension, independent of ornamentation and minor details of form.

What we claim as our invention, and desire

to secure by Letters Patent, is-

The design or pattern for a heating-stove, substantially as herein set forth and shown.
