

DESIGN FOR DRINKING-FOUNTAIN.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,488, dated July 20, 1875; application filed July 6, 1875. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOSEPH W. FISKE, of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a Design for a Drinking-Fountain, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

The design consists of a central polygonal column, having a series of ornamental basins arranged around it with a bracket under each. Above the basins are a corresponding series of ornamental dogs' heads, which serve as jets to deliver the water to the basins.

From this point upward the central column is ornamented by figures on its several facesit being enlarged in diameter and swelling gracefully outward at the top, where it is surmounted by a top piece, ornamented with scroll-work. This top piece, however, may be replaced by an ornamental gas-lamp without changing the design.

What I claim is—

The design for a drinking-fountain, substantially as herewith shown and described.
