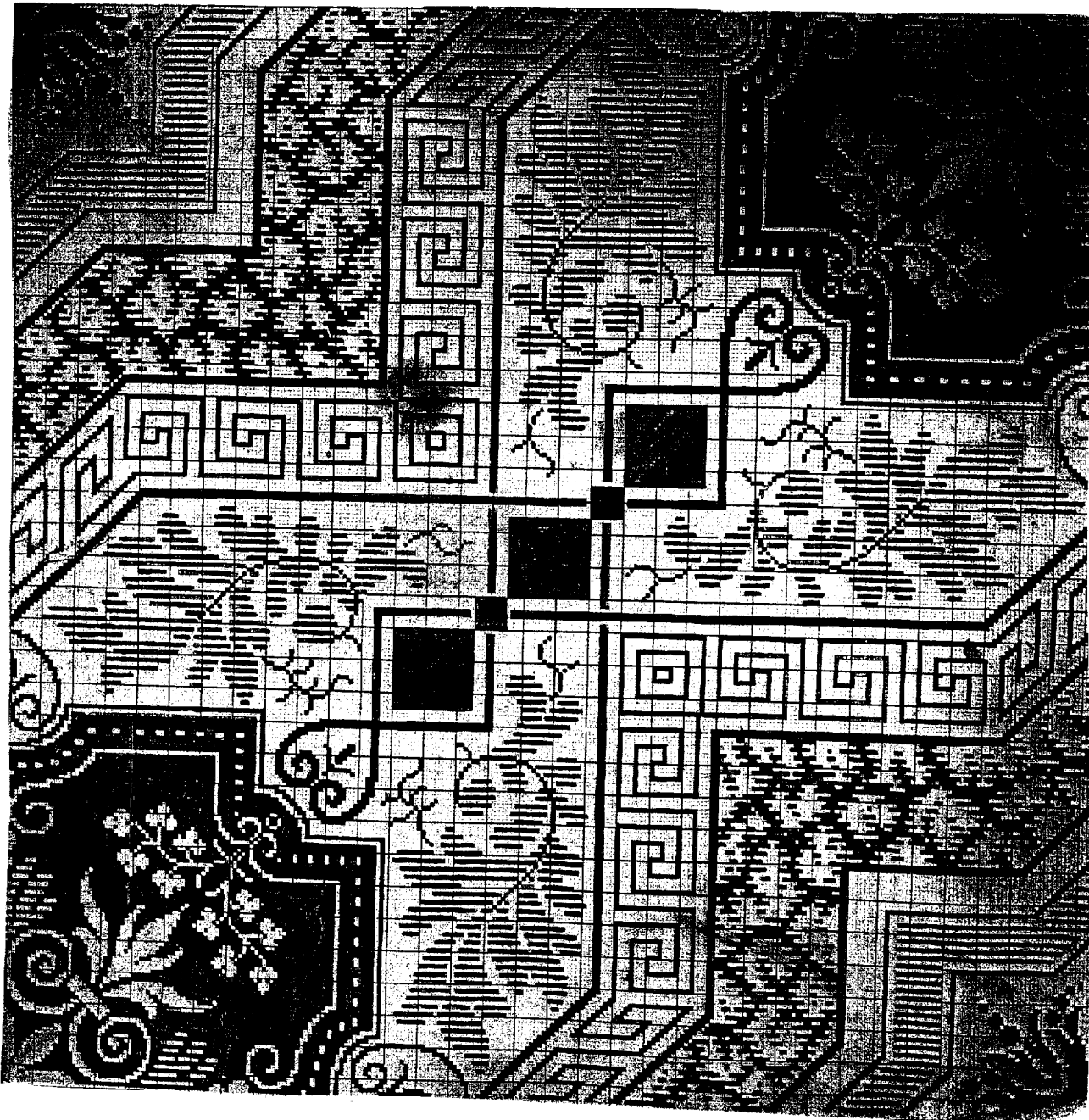

DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,564**, dated August 17, 1875; application filed August 7, 1875.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.]

CASE B'.

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, ALFRED HEALD, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have produced or invented a Design for a Carpet-Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

The accompanying photographic illustration represents sufficient of a carpet-pattern to illustrate the design, the remainder of the pattern being merely a repetition of that which appears.

The main features of the design are the two foliated scrolls A and B, which are interlocked with each other in the manner plainly shown in the drawing.

The intermediate spaces in the design are occupied by the ornaments D and E, the former

comprising the stem *a* and leaves *b*, and the latter a stem, *d*, and sprays composed of fine leaves *e*.

Irrespective of the minor ornamentation and of the colors employed, I claim—

The design for a carpet-pattern, substantially as described, and as shown in and by the accompanying drawing.
