DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,565**, dated August 17, 1875; application filed August 7, 1875.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.]

CASE C'.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED HEALD, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have produced or invented a Design for a Carpet-Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

The accompanying photographic illustration represents sufficient of a carpet-pattern to illustrate my design, the remainder of the pattern being merely a repetition of that which appears.

The main features of the design are the star-shaped figure A and the square figure B. The figure A is made up of a number of contiguous strips or bands, *a*, *b*, and *d*, and is provided with a central ornament, *e*, while the figure B has a border, *f*, around its edge, is indented at the extreme corners, and is provided with interior decoration of a foliated character, as clearly shown. From the corners of two opposite figures, B, extends a strip composed of heart-shaped scrolls *g* and

squares *h*, and the intervening spaces in the pattern are occupied with foliated ornamentation, as shown.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—

1. The design for the figure A, its bands *a*, *b*, and *d*, and central ornament *e*, as shown and described.
2. The design for the figure B, with its border *f* and interior foliated decoration, as shown and described.
3. The design for the whole pattern, including the figures A and B and minor ornamentation, as shown and described.
