

## DESIGN FOR A FAN.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,576, dated August 24, 1875; application filed August 16, 1875.

[Term of Patent 31 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John F. Langworthy, of the city, county, and State of New York, have originated a Design for Fans, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, which fully represents the nature of my design, and in which—

Figure 1 represents the obverse side of a fan. Fig. 2 represents the reverse side.

The letter A represents a fan, which may be of any suitable form or material, and is ornamented according to my design, which consists of an elevation of the building, known as "Gilmore's Concert Garden" in the city of New York, printed, photographed, or embossed, or otherwise produced upon the obverse side, substantially as illustrated in Fig. 1 of the drawing. Upon the reverse side may be placed, if desired, a representation of a vessel, with spread sails and with one or more persons therein, the said vessel being represented as sailing upon the water, as illustrated in Fig. 2.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

1. The design for a fan, consisting of a representation of the building known as "Gilmore's Concert Garden," in the city of New York, placed upon one side of the fan, substantially as herein shown and described.

2. The design for a fan, consisting of a representation of the building known as "Gilmore's Concert Garden" placed upon the obverse side, and of a vessel upon the water with spread sails, and one or more persons therein on the reverse side, substantially as herein shown and described.
