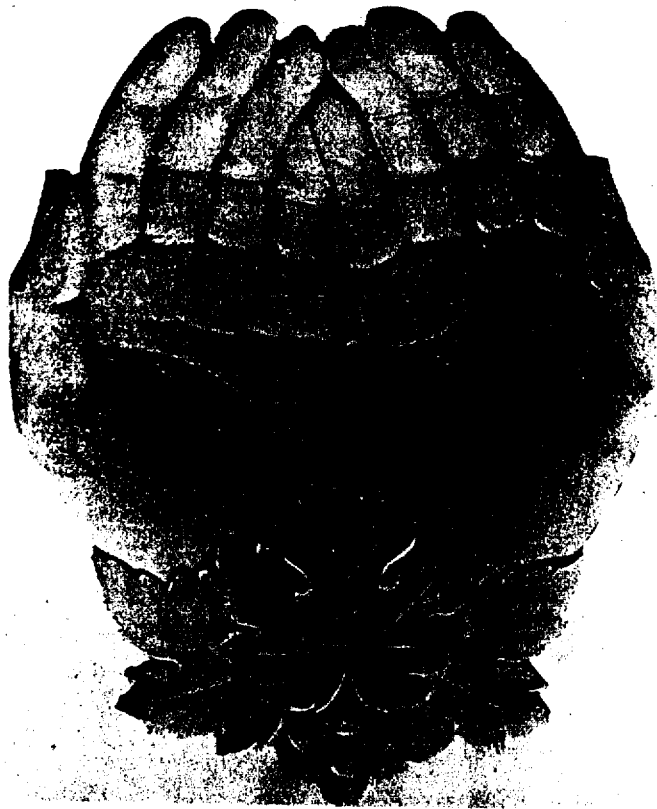

## DESIGN FOR GLASS FRUIT-DISH.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,585, dated August 31, 1875; application filed August 18, 1875.  
[Term of Patent  $3\frac{1}{2}$  years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, GEORGE E. HATCH, of East Cambridge, in the county of Middlesex and State of Massachusetts, have invented a Design for Glass Fruit-Dish, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, which shows a top view of a fruit-dish formed and ornamented in accordance with my invention.

The body of the dish, which is of a shallow concave form, I make of the shape of two united hands, the palms thereof, at the sides opposite the thumbs, being brought together in close impingement, the little fingers of each hand impinging, and with their ends lapping upon each other, the next finger of each hand meeting its fellow at their extremities, the remaining fingers, as well as the others resting laterally in close impact, while the thumbs are brought down so as to lap upon the index-fingers. At the base or wrists of the hands

I arrange a series or cluster of leaves, the middle one of which extends over and covers the junction of the palms, while from the base of the cluster of leaves hangs a cluster of acorns or grapes; but the cluster of leaves and grapes may be dispensed with, and some other figure or design substituted in place thereof, without departing from the spirit of my invention, the distinctive character of which is to be found in the figure composed of two hands arranged together, as shown.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design for a glass fruit-dish, composed essentially of the figure of two hands, arranged and combined as shown, and having any suitable wrist ornamentation, as described.
