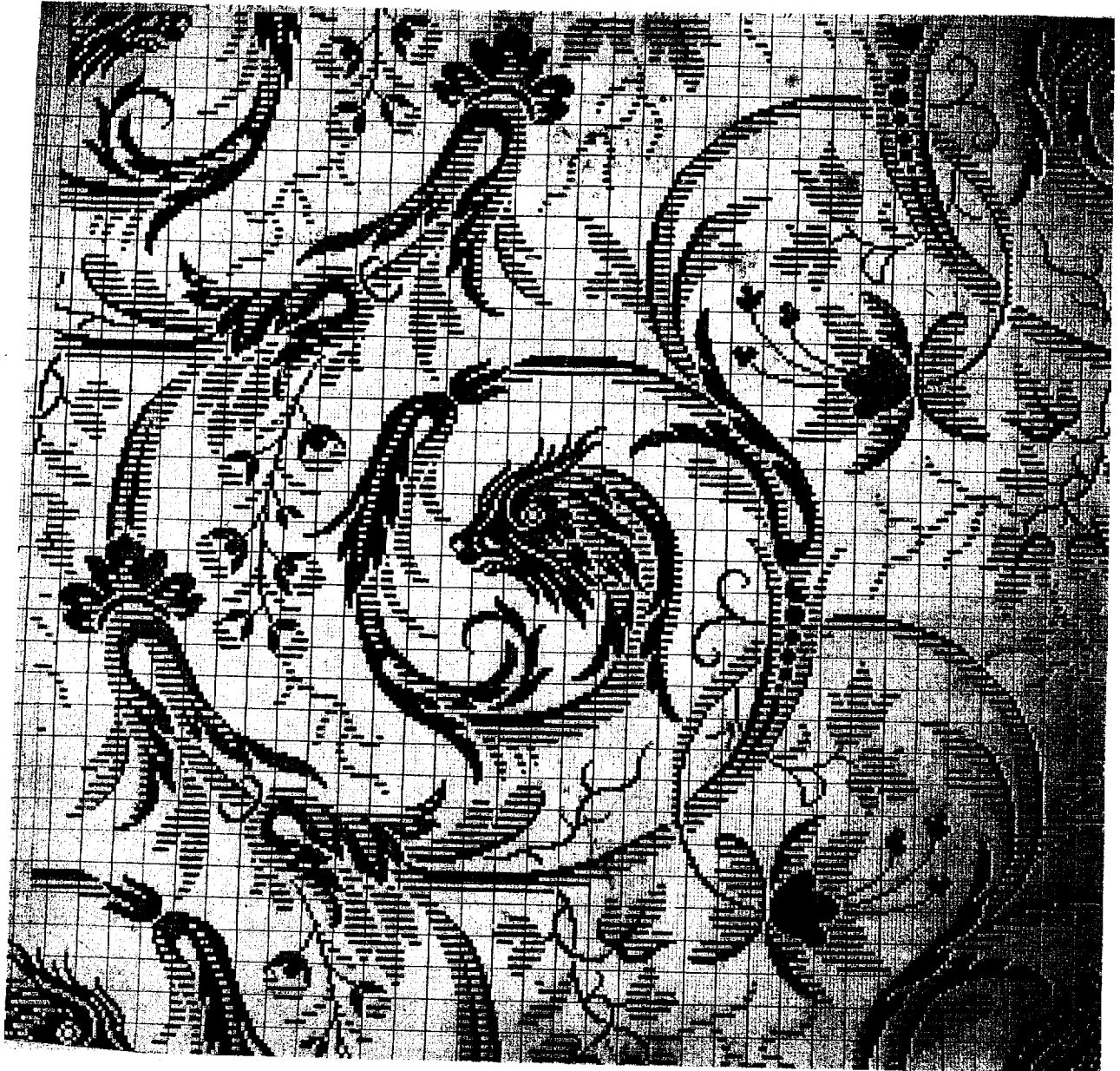

DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,586**, dated August 31, 1875; application filed August 21, 1875.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

CASE E'.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED HEALD, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a Design for a Carpet-Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

The accompanying photographic illustration represents sufficient of a carpet-pattern to illustrate my design, the remainder being merely a repetition of that which appears.

The design consists of a foliated scroll, A, of a character too clearly shown in the illustration to need detailed description. Each scroll is entwined on either side with a scroll of similar character, but running in a direction contrary to that of the scroll A. Each

of the scrolls terminates at the end in an ornament, a, representing the head of a dolphin.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—

The design for a carpet-pattern as described, and as illustrated in and by the accompanying drawing.
