

DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,588, dated August 31, 1875; application filed August 21, 1875.

[Term of Patent 34 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED HEALD, of Philadelphia. Pennsylvania, have invented a Design for a Carpet-Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

The accompanying photographic illustration represents sufficient of a carpet-pattern to illustrate my design, the remainder being merely a repetition of that which appears.

The main feature of the design is the figure A, which is in the form of a Greek cross. The body of the cross is composed of a checkered pattern, and in the center is a plain square portion, in which is arranged the central ornament a. Each end of the arms of the cross has a plain figure, b, forming a continuation of one of the corners of the central square.

The spaces between the figures A are occupied by strips composed of a series of small oblong ornaments connected together, and at each end of the strips are small circular ornaments d.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—

The design for a carpet-pattern, as described, and as illustrated in and by the accompanying drawing.
