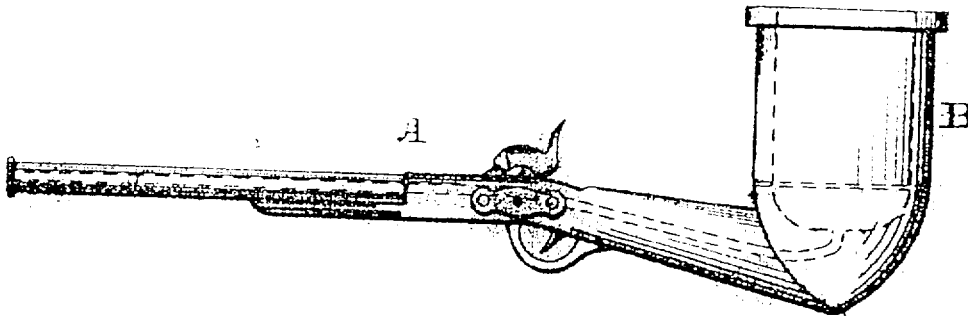

DESIGN FOR A PIPE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,656**, dated September 21, 1875; application filed September 10, 1875.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CLOUSE D. GRIMM, of Glenwood, in the county of Camden and State of New Jersey, have originated and designed a new and useful Design for Tobacco-Pipes, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

A represents the stem, which is of the form of a rifle. B represents the bowl, which is of

the form of a ball-cartridge, and it is joined to what represents the butt of the rifle.

The design will be found to be neat and graceful, and it is suggestive of the American rifle-team.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design for tobacco-pipe whose stem is in the form of a rifle, and bowl of the form of a ball-cartridge, as set forth and shown.
