

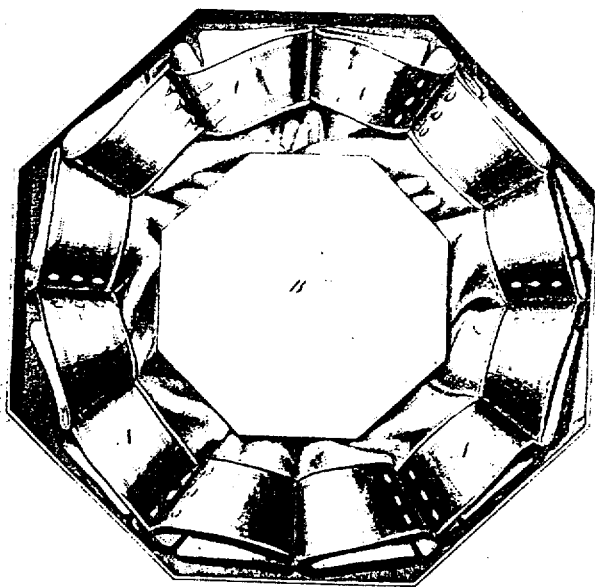

DESIGN FOR GANTLET-BOXES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,659**, dated September 21, 1875; application filed January 2, 1875.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, BYRON G. SHULTS, of Johnstown, Fulton county, New York, have invented a Design for a Gantlet-Package, of which the following is a specification:

My design for a gantlet-package is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

C designates an octagonal box, and B a center-piece or raised central portion of a similar shape. The cuffs A of the gantlets are arranged around the center-piece of the box, in the manner shown.

The said design consist of the circular or

approximately circular figure formed by the arrangement of the cuffs A, together with the center figure B, formed by the center-piece which covers the central portion of the package.

I claim as my invention—

The design for a gantlet box or package, consisting of the octagonal body and center-piece A B, as herein set forth and illustrated.
