

DESIGN FOR BOTTLES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,666**, dated September 28, 1875; application filed September 17, 1875.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE C. OVENS, of Red Bank, in the county of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, have invented a new and original Design for Bottles, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

The bottle is of rectangular form in crosssection, and is grooved and ribbed horizontally, forming rings one above another, some of which extend around three sides, only leaving

a plane space for the label, while others extend wholly around.

I claim—

As a design for a bottle, the rectangular body having horizontal ribs and grooves, forming rings extending partly around the lower portion, and wholly around the upper portion of the body, substantially as specified.
