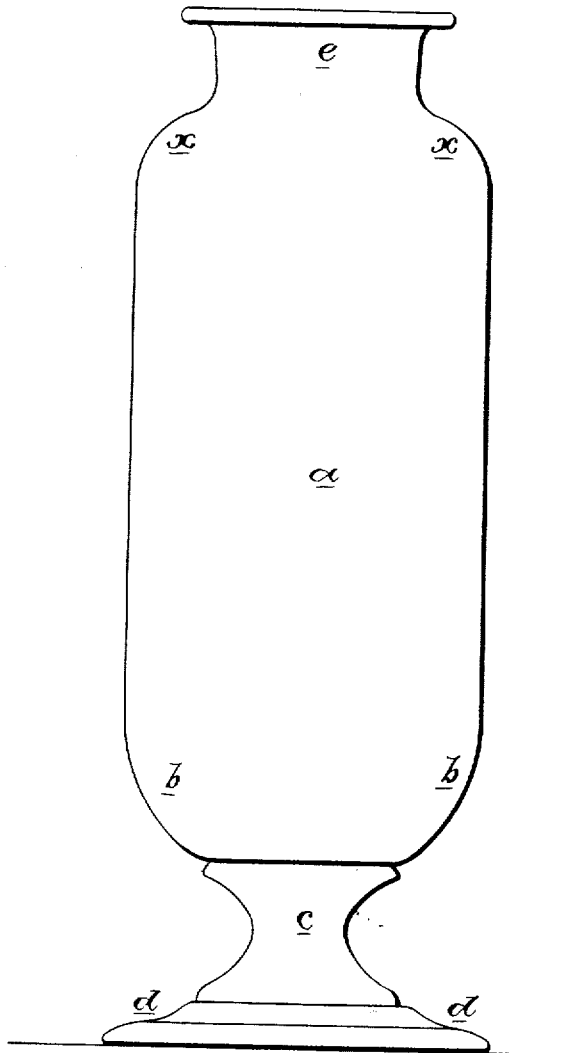

DESIGN FOR DRUGGIST'S SHOP-BOTTLES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,670**, dated September 28, 1875; application filed September 1, 1875.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM R. WARNER, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a Design for a Druggist's Shop-Bottle, of which the following is a specification:

My design for a shop-bottle for druggists is illustrated in the accompanying drawing.

The body *a* of the bottle is cylindrical throughout, and is rounded at the bottom *b*, where it joins the base, consisting of a stem, *c*, and foot *d*.

The cylindrical body is rounded at the top *x*, where it merges into the neck *e*.

I claim—

The design for a shop-bottle for druggists, substantially as described, and as represented in and by the accompanying drawing.
