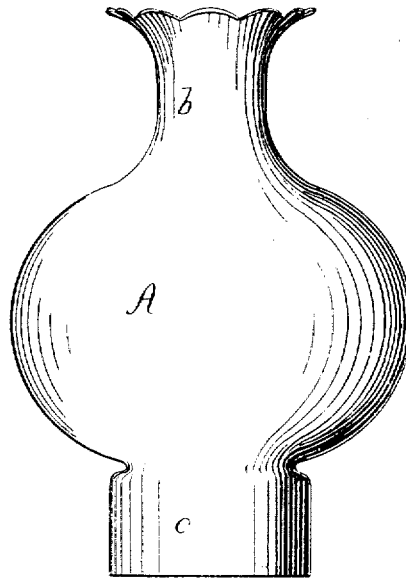
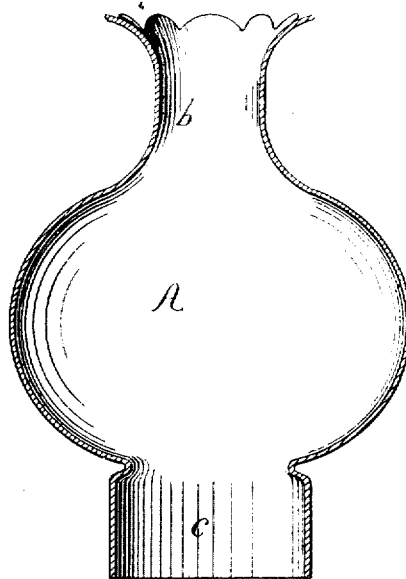

## DESIGN FOR LAMP SHADE AND CHIMNEY.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,673**, dated October 5, 1875; application filed September 20, 1875.  
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, THOMAS B. ATTERBURY, of Pittsburg, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have designed a new, useful, and original shape or configuration of an article of manufacture, constituting a Glass Lamp Globe-Shade and Lamp-Chimney in one piece, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing making a part of this specification, which drawing shows an elevation and vertical section.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, which shows a glass lamp globe-shade and a lamp-chimney in one piece, the shape or configuration of this article of manufacture being such as to

present in one piece a glass lamp globe-shade and a lamp-chimney, and this shape or configuration of this article of manufacture constitutes the distinctive character of my design.

A represents a glass globe-shade, presenting extensions *b* and *c* at its top and bottom, the shape or configuration of the whole showing a lamp globe-shade and a lamp-chimney in one piece.

I claim—

The design of the glass lamp globe-shade and chimney, substantially in the manner above described.
