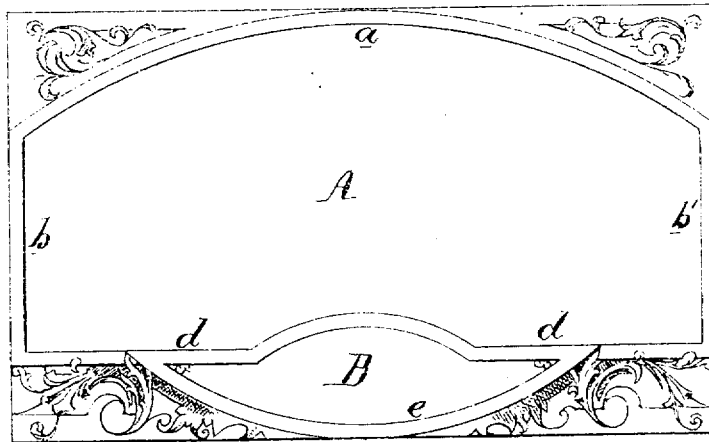

DESIGN FOR THE BORDER OF A PICTORIAL CARD.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,693**, dated October 5, 1875; application filed August 24, 1875.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MAHLON BOLTON, JR., of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a Design for the Border of a Pictorial Card, of which the following is a specification:

My design for the border of a pictorial card is fully represented in and by the accompanying drawing.

The card is of the usual oblong border, and on its face is printed a border inclosing two spaces or panels, A and B. The border for the space A has an arched top, *a*, two vertical sides, *b b*, and a base, *d*, partly straight and partly arched. The space B is inclosed by a border, consisting partly of the base *d* of the border of the upper space, and partly by an inverted arch, *e*.

The ornamentation of the corners of the

card outside the border form no part of my present design. In fact, different styles of ornamentation may be adopted for embellishing these portions of the card.

I claim—

The design for the border of a pictorial card, the said border inclosing two spaces or panels, A B, of a shape substantially as described, and illustrated in and by the accompanying drawing.
