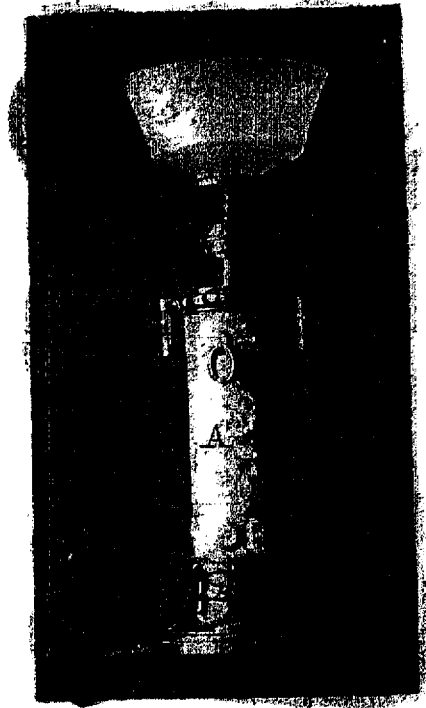

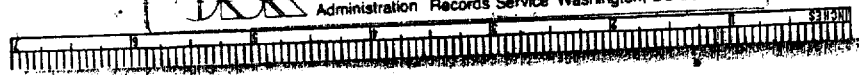

## DESIGN FOR A NEWELL LIGHT.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,700**, dated October 5, 1875; application filed September 27, 1875.  
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, CHRISTIAN HERTER, of the city of New York, N. Y., have invented a Design for a Newell Light, of which the following is a specification:

The illustration shows the nature of the design.

A denotes the trunk or body of the design, which consists of a Japanese or Chinese vase, of circular or cylindrical shape, mounted in the metallic forms B C, the configuration of which is clearly shown in the illustration. At the upper extremity are provided a globe-rest and globe, of any appropriate shape. The pendent rings D rest in projecting notches

upon the base of the form C, and the design is otherwise arranged and decorated, as shown in the illustration.

It is manifest that the minor details may be modified or omitted without changing the design as a whole.

I claim as my invention and production—

A design for a Newell light, substantially as shown and described.
