DESIGN FOR PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8.714, dated October 11, 1875; application filed August 25, 1875.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JAMES M. CONNER, of Greenville, Hudson county, New Jersey, have invented and originated a new and original Design for a Font of Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression; and consists of a font of printing-types designed in accordance therewith.

My design differs from the antique Tuscan extra condensed shown in the specimen-book of wood type made by W. H. Page & Co., in

that the face of the letters is more curved and less abrupt in its turns, and this difference is particularly shown in the capitals A, B, C, E, F, G, P, Q, R, S, and the lower-case a, g, r, s, and t.

What I claim as new is-

The design for a font of printing-types, as shown.
