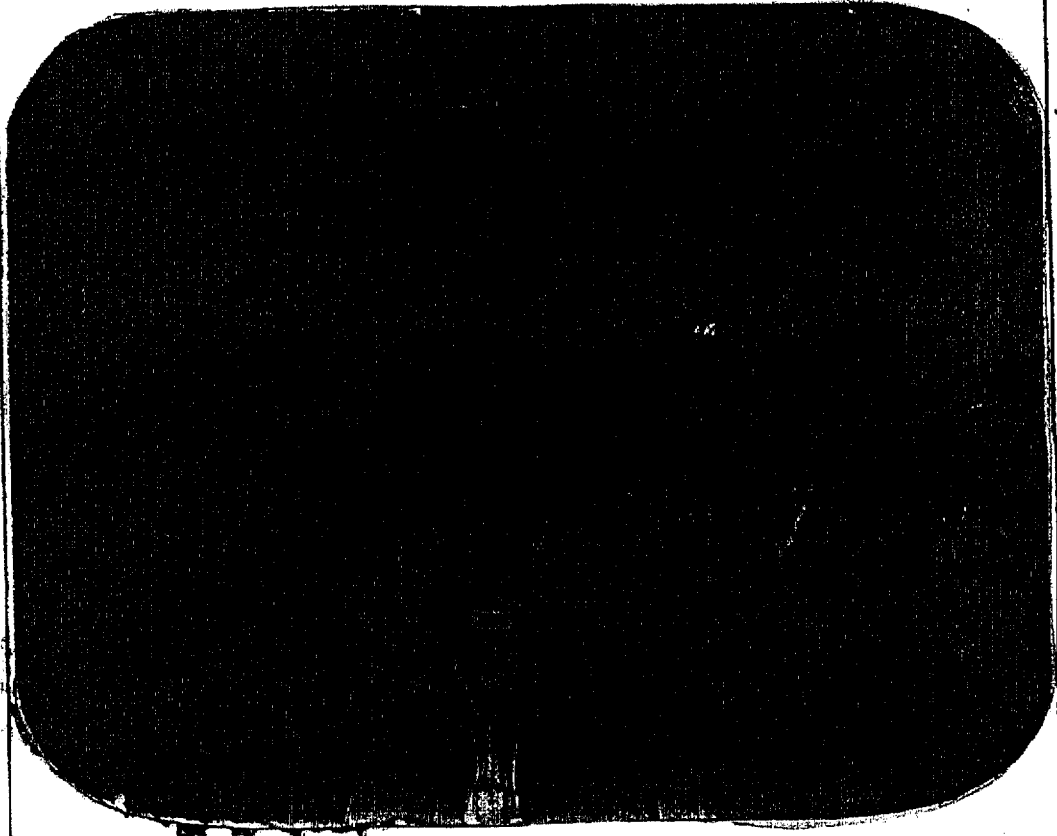

DESIGN FOR COOKING-STOVE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,718**, dated October 19, 1875; application filed October 2, 1875.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that we, JAMES BROWNBACK, THOMAS J. MARCH, JAMES ROGERS, and M. TOWERS, Jr., all of Limerick Station, county of Montgomery and State of Pennsylvania, constituting the firm of MARCH, BROWNBACK & Co., have originated a Design, Pattern, or Style of Cooking-Stoves, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, making part of this specification.

The nature of our design is fully represented in the accompanying illustration, to which reference is made.

Our design consists, as shown, of a raised ornamental circle, A, with four large projecting points, *a*, at opposite points to each other. Upon the face of this circle and these points are stars *b c*. Within the inclosed space of the circle A is an ornamented raised eight-pointed star, B, upon the points of which are

stars, and upon the face may appear the figures '76, '77, or '78, or other arrangement of letters or figures, as desired.

Our design, as thus represented, will form a neat, ornamental, and pleasing appearance and effect, and is a historical reminder, by the stars, &c., of the States of the Union.

What we claim as our invention is—

The design for stove-doors, consisting of raised ornamented circle A, central large star B, and small stars *b c*, all grouped and arranged substantially in the manner described.
