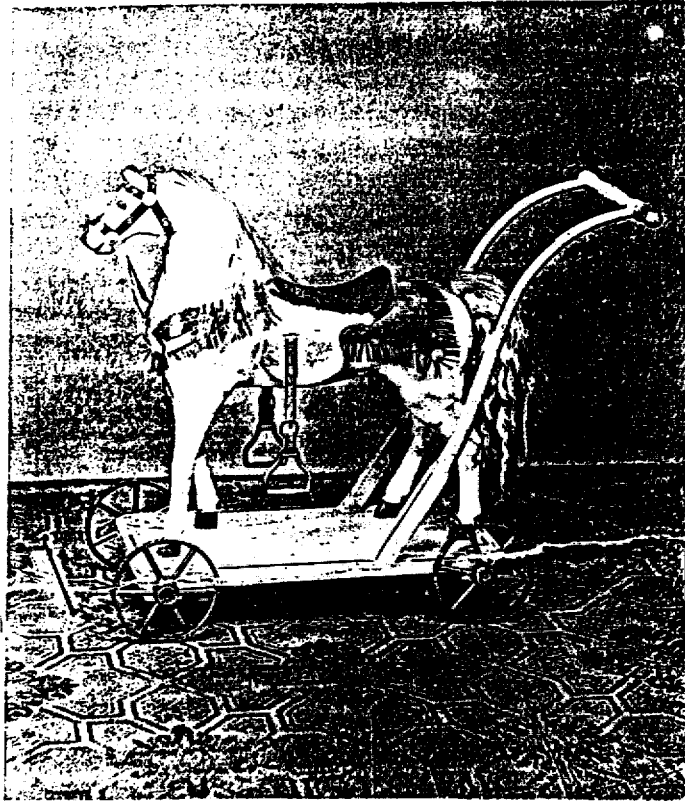

## DESIGN FOR A HOBBY-HORSE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,744**, dated October 19, 1875; application filed September 16, 1875.  
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ADOLPH SHOENINGER, of Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have originated and designed a Pattern for Hobby-Horses, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, making part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

A represents the hobby-horse; B, the platform, which is mounted on wheels C. Rising

from the platform B, near the rear end thereof, are standards D, being connected at their upper ends by the cross-bar or handle E.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design for a hobby-horse, comprising platform B, horse A, and handle D B, grouped together substantially as described, and shown in the accompanying photographic illustration.
